Please print legibly; this will cut your registration time.

Set up time is 9:30 am; March 20. President Roy will need your help and assistance for setting up our floor display. He will also chair the show set-up and break down for Kunia. To my knowledge there is no theme but we do need to figure out What? And How? We want to showcase our display. Do you have any suggestions as to what you would like to see or do? Please share them and we can collaborate. Let's make this show count and bring home a prize again!! In order to succeed we need you to bring your blooming orchids to put into our display. Please, please be courteous and don't bring infested plants. If you treat it now and the problem is gone, bring it otherwise leave it home. Don't forget to stake up your orchids.
